We expect income to be down this year due to COVID-19, likely worsening a negative cash flow situation that we've had for several years. That being the case, we would greatly appreciate any extra contributions.

Dogs

Dog walkers, please be careful to collect your dog's waste and take it home with you. Several full bags have been found at the park as well as in neighbors' yards. Having to dispose of someone else's dog waste is unpleasant for anyone, to say nothing of accidentally mowing over it. Please be conscientious and take care of it yourself.

Board Members

We need more board members. Please contact us if you are interested in any of these positions:

Park Maintenance: Monitor the park, fix vandalism, replace or remove worn playground equipment, and either cut down fallen trees or arrange to have them cut down. Coordinate major playground and pavilion repairs (see below). If needed, find a contractor to mow the park, though we currently have one.

Greeting new neighbors: Welcome new neighbors, get their contact info, and explain to them that joining BHCA helps take care of the neighborhood and the park. Maintain the neighborhood contact list.

Picnic coordinator: Pick a date for the fall picnic and notify everyone. Purchase hot dogs, hamburgers, beverages, and condiments. Folks normally bring sides, desserts, and place settings. Bring some kickballs and footballs for the kids.

Our challenges:

- We've had negative cash flow in recent years. Less than 50% of the households paid dues in 2019. At this rate we'll run out of money within a few years. We've done what we can to reduce expenses and try to communicate the need. Bottom line is we need more neighbors to participate.
- The pavilion needs major repairs. The exposed west wall is falling apart and has been subject to a recent break-in. The plywood patches around the door are a stopgap -- it needs replaced. The north edge of the roof is rotting away and the gutter is falling off. The light cover needs replaced.
