Hello neighbors!

We are going to have a vote on the use of our baseball field on Sunday, March 10th from 3:00 to 4:00 PM at the pavilion. We invite all paid members to participate. We want to hear your feedback and concerns. If you have any further questions after reading the information below, please contact me, Larry Cutright, at 717-395-2222, or any of the board members through berkshirehillscivic@gmail.com.

The members had a meeting on Sunday 2/25 at the request of the coach of the Dillsburg Polar Elite Softball travel team. They would like to use our field for practice from 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM or until dark, whichever comes first, Monday through Saturday, during the months of April through October. They will not hold games but may have an occasional scrimmage. They usually have a tournament on the weekends, but if not, they may use the field on Saturdays during the same time frame as above.

In return, they would install a sand infield with bases and a pitcher's mound, install a porta-potty, repair the back stop, which is in poor condition, mow the upper lot every week, and possibly level and reseed the outfield. I also asked them to regrade the property behind the pavilion so the water does not drain onto the concrete slab.

The teams are under-14 and under-12. The parents usually drop off their children. If they want to stay, they will be required to park on the field. If the field is full, they will park on the street, but only where there is a concrete curb. This means no parking on Creek Road, or on the section of Sheffield Drive that goes to the railroad tracks.

We will not be charging them a fee as the improvements and weekly mowing would offset the income we would normally assess.

Our members will have priority to reserve the field provided that you sign up a minimum of thirty days in advance by contacting the board at berkshirehillscivic@gmail.com. We will add a reservation schedule to our website if the vote is in favor of the softball team using our field.
