Hello neighbors! Hoping all is well as we struggle out of winter and into spring.

As we stated in our previous newsletter, we have been approached by a neighborhood member asking for use of the ball field at Kiehn Park this spring for scheduled girls' softball games and practices during the evening hours. They will be improving the infield, leveling the outfield, repairing the backstop, and regularly mowing the top portion of the park. With a prior scheduled notification to our residents, interested members met this past Sunday, 3/10, to discuss this request. After much discussion, we reached a unanimous vote in favor of proceeding with the endeavor, provided we have a clear, written mutual understanding on accident liability, hours of use, placement of the porta-potty, parking, and respect for neighboring properties. We have concluded with their use and proposed work to the field that the enhancements will benefit the park. We will keep you further informed.

As a reminder, the board has scheduled an Easter egg hunt for the kids in Kiehn Park on March 24 at 2:00 PM. The kids will hunt for eggs stuffed with toys and treats. A visit from the Easter Bunny will take place. We're hoping for a beautiful spring day to celebrate the holiday. We welcome all to attend.
